MEMORANDUM FOR AFROTC DET 890 CADETS

SUBJECT: Detachment 890 Cadet Uniform Issuing Guidance

1. This memo serves to establish procedures for the issuing of cadet uniforms at Detachment 890 and complies with Chapter 4 of AFROTCI 23-1001, Cadet Uniform Program Management.
2. All uniform items, except those designated as Non-Stock Listed Depot Items in Table 4.2 of AFROTCI 23-1001, will be issued by detachment cadre using the KYLOC ordering system if not already in the detachment inventory. Those items listed in Table 4.2 will be purchased using a designated uniform GPC via an authorized third-party vendor.
3. The following establishes Detachment 890's gated uniform allowance for General Military Course (GMC) cadets:
 - a. Cadets who completed Cadet Candidate Training (CCT) will be issued an Air Force polo shirt, which will be worn with either black shorts, blue jeans, or khaki slacks as prescribed by the weekly Cadet Wing Operations Order (OPORD).
 - b. Cadets who successfully pass an official Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA) will be issued the Air Force PT uniform to include the wool knit hat.
 - c. Cadets will be issued the Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCP) uniform after the successful completion of their first semester in AFROTC. Cadets must have a passing PFA, a qualified Department of Defense Medical Evaluation Review Board (DoDMERB) physical on file, and meet the minimum AFROTC GPA requirements before a uniform will be ordered/issued.
 - d. Cadets will be issued all components of the Air Force Blues uniform, except the Service Coat, at the beginning of their AS200 year. AS250s will be issued the Air Force Blues uniform, except the service coat, at the beginning of their second semester if meeting the AFROTC standards mentioned in paragraph 3.c.
4. Professional Officer Course (POC) cadets will be issued all components of Air Force uniforms to include the Air Force Service Coat.

5. Cadets who receive a Pilot (92T0), CSO (92T1), ABM (92T2) or RPA (92T3) slot, as well as those designated for Nuclear Operations (13N), will be issued an Air Force flight suit.
6. Cadets who decide to leave AFROTC, or who are dropped/disenrolled from the program, must return all uniform items except the footwear, coyote brown t-shirts, PT shirt and shorts, neckties or tie tabs, belts, headgear, and gloves. Uniform items must be dry-cleaned before returning. The detachment will coordinate with the respective universities to put a hold on a cadet's account, or contact the Defense Finance Accounting Service for repayment if the situation dictates, if a cadet fails to return uniform items.
7. Upon commissioning, only flight suites are required to be returned.
8. This memorandum serves as general uniform issuance guidance only. Cadre members are authorized to issue uniform items in unique circumstances, as they deem necessary. For questions or concerns, please contact me at msh4ct@virginia.edu.
